Project Aim

Antalya Bilim University (ABU) Takes Part in EU-Funded “RISE Resilient Communities” Project: ABU is a partner in RISE Resilient Communities, a new European Union-funded project focusing on disaster preparedness and community resilience. The project is supported under the Erasmus+ Programme and coordinated by Consorci de la Ribera (Spain), which brings together the associations of municipalities of Ribera Alta and Ribera Baixa. Launched in September, RISE Resilient Communities aims to strengthen communities’ capacity to anticipate, prepare for, and respond to disasters through adult education, digital learning, and innovation-driven approaches. The project integrates environmental resilience, risk mitigation strategies, and participatory learning models to support long-term recovery and sustainable community development. Alongside ABU, the consortium includes EXO Società Consortile (Italy), Building Ukraine Together (Ukraine), and two Irish organisations: Momentum Educate + Innovate and Gairmeach Training Limited. Within the scope of the project, more than 80 educators and community leaders will receive specialised training in disaster preparedness and resilience. In addition, over 250 adults from disaster-affected communities in the La Ribera region will participate in structured training programmes supported by digital tools and innovative learning methods. The project will also produce a compilation of European best practices in disaster recovery. A key component of the project is the Innovation Lab, where stakeholders will co-design disaster recovery solutions using digital technologies and participatory models, ensuring that outcomes are both scalable and sustainable. The project will run for 24 months. After its completion, all training materials and outputs will be made publicly accessible, enabling continued learning and capacity building in disaster mitigation and prevention. ABU contributes to the project through its expertise in education, innovation, and community-based approaches, supporting the development of resilient and prepared societies across Europe.
